

Add NECPE search to your website

Create a free embed link, then hand it to whoever manages your brokerage's website. They paste it in — and your site gets a live NECPE search box.

Embeds are an admin feature. Don't see Embeds in your menu? Ask the NECPE team.

What is an embed link?

An embed is a free, copy-and-paste NECPE search box you can drop onto your own website. Visitors search live NECPE listings without ever leaving your site. You create the link in NECPE; your website manager pastes it onto the site.

The Embeds page in NECPE — click **New embed** to get started.

Open Embeds and click New embed

Sign in to NECPE. Open the **user menu** (your initials in the top-right corner) and choose **Embeds**. Then click **New embed**.

Only admins see Embeds. If it's not in your menu, you're not set up as an admin — the NECPE team can help.

Fill in the three details

- **Label** — a name so you recognize it later, like your brokerage or the website it lives on.
- **Market office(s)** — choose which office's listings the embedded search should show.
- **Website address** — attach the domain where it will live, such as *yourbrokerage.com*.

Save, then copy the iframe snippet

Save the embed. NECPE gives you a short block of code (an “iframe”). Click to **copy** it.

THE CODE NECPE GIVES YOU

Hand the snippet to your website manager

You're done in NECPE. Give that copied code to whoever runs your website — they paste it onto the page where the search should appear.

You usually won't paste it in yourself. That's a job for your web person or service.

THE MOST IMPORTANT PART

What to do with your embed link

An embed link is added onto your website so visitors can see NECPE listings. Once you create the embed, **take the link and give it to whatever group, service, or person in your brokerage runs and manages your website.** They paste it in — you don't have to touch the website yourself.

COMMON QUESTIONS

I don't see “Embeds” in my menu

Embeds is an admin-only feature. If it's missing, your account isn't set up as an admin. Ask the NECPE team and they can either enable it or create the embed for you.

Where exactly do I paste the code?

You normally don't. Send the copied iframe snippet to whoever manages your website — your marketing team, web designer, or web service. They drop it onto the page where you want the search box to show.

Does it cost anything?

No. Adding a NECPE search embed to your website is free.

Can it show more than one office?

Yes. When you create the embed, you choose which market office or offices the search includes.

What if our website changes?

The embed keeps working as long as the snippet stays on the page. If you ever need to point it at a different site or office, come back to Embeds and create or update one, then hand off the new snippet.
